The Piemonte Villa now boasts heated pool, tennis court and lawns stretching to its private lakeside mooring, all with lake views to die for. The stunning conservatory restaurant makes a perfect spot to enjoy a romantic meal with Lake Maggiore shimmering below. This most welcoming of 5 star luxury hotels is the perfect choice for a romantic holiday or honeymoon in the Italian Lakes.

### Details

The Piemonte Villa was originally constructed as a nobleman's holiday residence and is now run by a charming family, who have overseen the restorations using their love of antiques and interior design. Arrive in style from nearby Milan airport by private helicopter or limo transfer. The Villa bears all the hallmarks of 19th century style, with spacious rooms, ornately carved mouldings, pretty balconies and marbled floors. The antique furnishings are in keeping with the period, and all guest rooms have stuccoed and hand-painted walls. Many of the suites have impressive mezzanine level bedrooms and most rooms have private balconies with lake views.

Guests can take their breakfast of freshly baked cakes and breads on the large flowered terrace, with fabulous views across Lake Maggiore, where you can trace the paths of the little boats chugging between the Lake's islands. Spend the day relaxing by the pool, take a trip into town or just promenade along the lake front with an ice-cream from Stresa's famous ice-cream parlour. You could also indulge in one of the hotel's fine courses in cookery, wine tasting, ceramic painting or decoupage. At night, with the twinkling lights of the opposite shore and nearby islands in the background, the hotel terrace makes a magical setting for an evening cocktail before dinner in the elegant conservatory restaurant.

Romantics will be won over by the panoramic lakeside walks or hire a private boat to visit the islands dotted in the Lakes, whilst die-hard shoppers will be satisfied with the abundance of boutiques in the many elegant towns of the region, as well as in Milan itself. Sports enthusiasts will also find a variety of water-sports on offer. Golf, horse-riding, mountain biking and hiking is also available in the nearby national parks and for the less ambitious, there's a cable car to the top of the nearest mountain, from where you can drink in stunning vistas of the Lake below. And for trips further a field you could even drive down to the Winelands, or Italian Riviera to the south.
