

## The Post House – Agriturismo Farmhouse: Puglia

### Summary

This charming small farmhouse lies in the verdant Itria Valley area of Puglia. The characteristic white-washed farmhouse has been family owned for generations and still boasts many original features. The simple guest rooms in the pretty courtyard are light and airy, with wicker furniture. Being just a short drive from the hilltop town of Ostuni and the beach, this is a great value farmhouse for exploring Puglia.

### Details

Days at The Post House start with breakfast served in the flowered courtyard. To one side, a small gate leads to a lawned garden with sun loungers, where you can while away the day. A little further exploration will reveal a small farmyard where a few chickens, geese and goats are kept for the entertainment of any younger guests.

The Post House is an 'agriturismo' so naturally the heart of the building is its fine restaurant. The white-washed pillars and exposed stone of the vaulted ceilings make the perfect environment in which to enjoy the home cooked food. All the ingredients are grown on the family's farmland and the typical local recipes are prepared for you by "Nona" (their grandmother).

A half board option is available for guests, which will usually be dinner, although on Sundays and Italian feast days, a special celebration lunch is offered instead.
