

## The Seaview Manor – Agriturismo Farmhouse: Puglia

### Summary

This newly renovated farmhouse in Puglia boasts a brand new panoramic pool and upgraded accommodation. It is set on the beautiful and wild Salento coast, near Lecce (the famous baroque town) and the pretty port of Otranto. The farmhouse has unrivalled coastal views down to the craggy bay of Porto Badisco, perfect for a romantic holiday or honeymoon. This is a very reasonably priced farmhouse in Puglia, set in fabulous surroundings with pretty fishing ports dotted along the coastline and delicious food awaiting you after a day's explorations.

### Details

The Seaview Manor dates back to the 15th century but over the last three years it has been restored by the family owners. Stately lawns and terraces for guests surround the farmhouse but there is no escaping the wildness of country beyond. The region is ideal for mountain biking and trekking. From Otranto, the nearby fishing port, you can also take scuba diving or snorkelling trips to explore the fascinating coastline.

The guest rooms lead off the pretty courtyard, some with sea views. The walls are painted a pretty ochre, which contrasts perfectly with the stonework of the outer structure. All rooms are very comfortably equipped and fitted with wooden and wrought iron furniture, all in keeping with the period.

The farmhouse has a renowned restaurant, which is set in a lofty, pillared chamber. Italians travel from many miles around to sample the food here; fresh fish, traditional pasta and local cheeses and sweets. The owner also has plans to bring his team of chefs to London in order to host an evening of Pugliese cuisine
