

Daffodil House – Charming Boutique Hotel: Sardinia

Summary

This small luxury boutique hotel is a beautifully restored Liberty villa on the west coast of Sardinia, just south of Alghero. It offers excellent value on the rather glamorous island of Sardinia. Set close to pristine sandy beaches in a traditional Sardinian village away from the tourist traps, it's an idyllic spot with sea-views to die for. There's a homely, family-run atmosphere without any compromise on luxury, and some rooms include a kitchen for self-catering holidays. The lovely gardens and pool complete the picture. This charming boutique hotel is a wonderful choice for authentic holidays in Sardinia.

Details

Named after the local meadow daffodil, this gorgeous liberty building preserves a wealth of period features and offers the opportunity to sample a slice of traditional Sardinian life. Set in the church square of a picturesque village on the West Coast of the Caribbean-like island, it feels far enough off the beaten track to avoid the hoards, but near enough to the attractions of historic towns and sandy beaches to avoid complete isolation.

As well as rooms and suites in the main building (some with kitchenettes for those wishing to cater for themselves) there are also some cottage rooms in the gardens. All are decorated with tasteful simplicity, and showcase the ancient fireplaces, mosaic floors and stucco ceilings with subtle use of colours and antiques. A pillow menu is offered to ensure complete comfort.

The hotel's elevated position offers sweeping views across the patchwork countryside leading down to the local sandy beaches and crystal clear waters. This is an enchanting corner of Sardinia, often overlooked in favour of the glitzy Emerald Coast just 90 minutes away (perfect for a glamorous day trip). In the village you'll still see grandmothers basket-weaving with daffodil leaves and lace-making in the streets. There are a wealth of local festivals as well with Carnival in February and a succession of Feasts over the summer months.

Of course, a big draw is the beaches, where you can snorkel, sail, canoe, wind- and kite-surf. Take a boat trip or even hire a private boat to skipper yourself. Tennis, horse-riding and mountain-biking are also on hand.
