The guest rooms are sumptuous, many with 4-posters and luxuriant private "spa" bathrooms. A distinctively quirky hotel, it's a perfect spot for both relaxing or activity holidays in Sardinia.

Details

A real favourite with us because of its flamboyant style and fabulous mountain backdrop, the hotel takes its name from the dramatic spring which gushes up through the rocks nearby; the water is even used to feed the swimming pool. It's easy to relax in this idyllic, verdant spot and just drink in the panoramic vistas. Massages and beauty treatments galore are available in the spa, or pool-side.

Days end with a traditional Sardinian meal on offer in the pretty restaurant. The "show-kitchen" turns dinner into entertainment in itself as the chefs cook in the ancient open fireplace.

For those looking for more action, there's plenty on offer from mountain treks on foot or bicycle, to quad-bike and 4x4 expeditions. At the nearby pretty lake, there is canoeing. More watersports are available on Sardinia's stunning eastern beaches, an easy drive away and the hotel also boasts a well equipped fitness room.

The whitewashed, shuttered guest rooms are charming and spacious, with luxurious décor in a local country style. Many rooms boast exposed beams. Most have balconies or terraces and the suites are extraordinary, with private Jacuzzi "spa bathrooms", some even within the master bedroom itself, in addition to a more traditional bathroom. Everywhere there are colourful, stylish touches. The artistic flare is due in no small part to the fact that the family owners have used their own private collection of artwork and sculptures to bring the hotel to life.
